

Reimbursement for administrative and transportation services has been protected

CMS 2287 to be rescinded!

Lansing, Michigan - Friday May 1st, 2009 - The following FINAL regulations are being RESCINDED: (CMS 2287), school-based administrative and transportation services, and (2237), targeted case management. These regulatory actions are posted on the Federal Register at [2009-10494 PI.pdf](#).

The notice also indicates that there will be a thirty day public comment period, which means that the regulation would go into effect prior to June 30, when the current moratorium expires.

You are encouraged to submit your comments during the public comment period. We will pass along instructions for submitting comments. Go Solutions will be offering our comments, which we will share with you.

It has been a long and arduous battle to save these reimbursement programs and they can certainly help alleviate some of the fiscal problems facing many school districts.
